DAWN'S EARLY SKY three deep on the first turn, chased outside outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and rallied under urging outside to get up nearing the wire. TAP IT LIGHT chased a bit off the rail, came out some in the stretch, gained a slim advantage between horses in deep stretch and was edged late. GALLARDO leaned back, broke in the air and behind the field, settled a bit off the rail then chased three deep to the stretch and continued willingly to the end. SEVEN SECRETS sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the drive and was overtaken in deep stretch. SENSATIONAL SCORE chased inside then between horses, continued outside a rival leaving the second turn, split foes into the stretch and continued willingly inside. NICE BET (BRZ) saved ground chasing the leader, continued inside in the stretch and lacked the needed response.

OUTLAW JAMES allowed to settle outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, angled to the inside in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. RED REDDING broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, went three deep into the turn, continued outside a rival in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. REEL PRIME settled off the pace inside, continued along the fence in the stretch and was not a threat.

STREET MATCH squeezed a bit at the start, five wide into the first turn, stalked outside, bid three deep leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch and pulled clear under a steady hand ride. VIOLET SKY (IRE) saved ground stalking the pace, bid inside on the second turn and into the stretch and just held the place. GENTLEMEN'S CROWN broke a bit slowly, pulled a bit off the rail then chased inside, came out in the stretch and split horses late for third. B. A. HOMEBODY chased between horses then outside a rival leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. HALO'S CLEAN SHEET sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled outside a rival on the second turn and between horses nearing the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MOLITTA stalked inside then between horses on the backstretch and into the second turn, continued off the rail leaving that turn and weakened. MOZAMBIQUE six wide into the first turn, settled outside then off the rail and failed to menace. MARWAH (GB) seven wide into the first turn, settled outside then angled in some on the backstretch and lacked a response in the lane. HIGH PERFORMANCE stalked outside a rival then three deep early on the second turn, steadied in tight between foes midway on that turn and gave way.

PEACE ACCORD chased between horses then inside, came out into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up late. RUN FOREST RUN stalked inside, bid along the rail on the turn, re-bid past midstretch inside the pacesetter, put a head in front in late stretch but was caught. FOR THE HOUSE sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail then outside the runner-up on the turn, inched away again in the stretch, fought back in deep stretch and held third. CACTUS LIGHTING chased outside then four wide, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and just missed the show. EDDIE MUNSTA pulled a bit early, stalked outside then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SCOTT'S POPPY chased between horses, came out into the stretch and did not rally. YOUNG THOMAS chased between horses then outside into and on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. BARTOKS BRAVEHEART also chased between horses then outside a rival on the turn and did not rally. FALSTAFF LANE angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, remained inside and was not a threat. WILD HUNTSMAN steadied at the start, settled off the rail and was outrun. GAINING PROSPERITY dropped back off the rail, lost contact with the field when always outrun and was eased in the stretch. CASTING CROWNS chased between horses then outside, dropped back on the turn, was pulled up in distress and vanned off.
